## MEXICAN AMERICAN GOLF ASSOCIATION STATE TOURNAMENT GUIDELINES

PURPOSE: to provide consistent guidelines to the Tournament Committee for the preparation and the conducting of the California Mexican American Golf Association's Annual State Tournament.

## State Tournament Director Responsibilities/Functions:

- Oversee the budget.
- Ensure the Chapter/Council running the tournament has the current By-Laws and State Tournament Guidelines.
- Ensure the By-Laws and State Tournament Guidelines are followed throughout the tournament process.
- Meet with the Chapter/Council Tournament Committee running the tournament as needed.


## 1. PREPARATIONS:

The Annual State Tournament should be set up to take place over the Labor Day weekend in September. Hosting Council or Chapters should make every effort to schedule the Labor Day weekend in the State Tournament pre-package proposal. Pre-package proposal shall be presented at the second quarterly State meeting and finalized at the third quarterly meeting of the prior year of State Tournament.
A. Hosting Council shall make determination of Chapter(s)/Council to Host State Tournament by the Councils first quarterly meeting of the prior year of the State Tournament.
B. Tournament shall be based on a break-even basis. Cost of tournament must be kept at a reasonable and agreeable fee to the State Governing Board.
C. Formula to be used - See Attachment "A."

## 2. NEGOTATIONS:

A. Sponsors shall be solicited solely for the benefit of the tournament. Cap or shirt may be purchased for committee members for identity at State Tournament. Neither tournament funds nor sponsor donations shall be used for Council/Chapter(s) or individual gain.

## 3. TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE RESPONSIBILITIES AND FINANCIAL ACCOUNTING REQUIREMENTS:

A. If State Board provides advance funds to ensure reservations and appropriate contracts, host Council/Chapter shall reimburse state Board no later than the November State meeting after the tournament.
B. If needed, open new bank account with four names on signature card. A final report should be submitted prior to the fourth quarter meeting. The State will appoint an audit chairperson.
C. Submit a preliminary Income \& Expense Budget (Attachment "A") at the third or fourth quarterly State meeting of the prior year.
D. Committee shall stay within the budget and not overspend, barring any unforeseen circumstances.
E. Income \& Expense spreadsheet ledgers shall be used to keep record of the account, Spreadsheet should use the categories on the Profit \& Loss Statement.

1. Record all monies received within each category. Each deposit shall reflect all individual entries and shall be recorded in the income spreadsheet in its designated column.
2. Record all monies paid out separately. Checks shall not be issued for amounts over what charge or invoice reflects. If the band or Mariachi is paid a deposit and then require cash payment for balance at end of engagement an individual check for each balance shall be cashed in advance. Each check shall be recorded in its designated column.
3. Optional, not part of entry fee; All optional money games (i.e. Skins, money holes, etc.) These shall be kept track of on attachment C, State Tournament Formula \& Budget Forecast. Participant lists on each category shall be submitted to the audit committee.
F. All bank monthly statements, including the opening statement, consecutive monthly statement, while the account was in effect, and the final closing statement shall be submitted to the Tournament Auditing Committee.
G. Accountability of entry fees, dinner/dance, raffles, and all other income producing activities and a full written report with supporting vouchers, receipts, etc. shall be furnished and submitted to auditing committee within sixty ( 60 ) days after the tournament. A final report of the above should be presented at the fourth quarterly meeting.
H. Audit shall be completed, and a written report of all accounts (open or closed) shall be submitted to the State Board at the fourth quarter meeting of the tournament year. An audit form shall be attached to the report. Enclosed should be a form that will serve as a checklist of all income and expenses (i.e., do all deposits coincide with spreadsheet and do the cancelled checks or cash receipts coincide with the spreadsheet). The audit committee consists of the Council Directors and the Treasurer.
4. For accounting of income and expenses the State will provide spreadsheets or journal ledgers to the hosting Council or Chapter(s).

## 4. HOSTING COUNCIL OR CHAPTER REQUIREMENTS AND BENEFITS:

A. State will provide seed money up to a maximum of $\$ 2,500.00$.
B. Hosting chapter will share in the net profits based on $40 \%$ State and $60 \%$ hosting council or chapter(s).
C. Council or Chapter(s) shall have minimum of 30 members to bid for the State Tournament.
D. Hall capacity to accommodate tournament participation for dinner/dance.
E. One (1) or two (2) championship 18 holes golf courses or Three (3) 9 hole adjoining courses shall be reserved for the State Tournament.
F. Maximum of 240 golfers ( 120 golfers on each course) for tournament. Contract with golf courses shall be negotiated so player count can be reduced without penalty by entry and/or golf course deadline.
G. The dinner/dance is optional depending on the tournament venue.

## 5. HOSTING COUNCIL:

Rotation of the Annual State Tournament will be from Northern to Central to Southern Council. If hosting Council is not able to host tournament, the State Board/committee may assume responsibility to run the tournament.

## 6. ENTRY FORMS:

A. Tournament Committee shall provide entry forms to the member no later than June 1. Deadline for return of entry form by members shall be 30 days before Tournament, after such date, entries from members and guests shall be accepted until tournament is filled.
B. Cancellations shall be accepted no later than ten (10) days prior to Tournament or the golf course cancellation contract deadline date.

## 7. TOURNAMENT CHAIRPERSON:

Tournament Chairperson and/or Tournament Committee is responsible for properly arranging all tournament details to allow golfers to participate in a competitive atmosphere.
A. Format- See Attachment "B"
B. Index- the August Index will determine handicap to be used. Maximum Handicap for any flight is Men 36, Women 40.
C. Insurance- If Tournament site or hall require insurance coverage, the Tournament Director will notify the State Administration who will then secure the necessary insurance riders. This insurance does not cover Liquor License.
D. Flight Tees- The Championship Flight and the current M.A.G.A. gross State Champion shall tee up from the Championship Tees. The Championship flight shall tee up on the same course each day and not be separated. All other Men Flights (except the Golden 80's) and Junior boys will tee up from the Regular Men's Tees. The Golden 80s flight will tee up from 1 (one) tee forward of the Regular Men's tees. Women and Junior girls will tee up from the Ladies Tees. Should women declare to play in any other flight, USGA rules will be followed.
E. Tie Breakers- In the event of Overall Low Gross ties after the tournament, tied participants shall engage in a sudden death play-off. Tournament Chairman will determine hole(s) after consulting with golf course. All other ties shall be determined by using USGA recommendations.
F. Tournament scores shall be posted daily and displayed in a prominent place for participant's information.
G. Only S.C.G.A., S.C.P.L.G.A., and N.C.G.A. computerized systems will be recognized.
H. A tee prize commemorating Tournament may be provided for all golfers attending (i.e., hats, towels, visor, etc.). A tee prize shall bear M.A.G.A. logo.
I. Shotgun start both days will commence with a moment of silence in memory of our founder, Mr. Nash Fernandez and other deceased M.A.G.A. members.
J. Ladies program optional at State Tournaments.
K. Spotters/Marshals may be used at State Tournaments, if allowed by the golf course, to promote faster play.

## 8. ELIGIBILITY:

A. For any current or reinstated member to be eligible to win in any flight at the State Tournament, he/she must have been a member in good standing as of the first quarterly State meeting of the current year.
B. Any new member who joins prior to April $1^{\text {st }}$ will be eligible to win in any flight at the State Tournament.
C. Any new member who joins April $1^{\text {st }}$ or later is only eligible to win in the Guest Flight.
D. It is the responsibility of the chapter officials to inform all their new or reinstated members of their State Tournament eligibility. This disclaimer shall also be on entry flier.

## 9. STATE TOURNAMENT EXEMPTIONS:

A. The current low gross Champions in the Men's (all men's flights inclusive), Ladies, Senior, Super

Senior, Golden 80's and Junior flights shall be required to pay green fees only. The hosting Chapter/Council may grant them further exemptions if they choose to subsidize the costs incurred.
B. Host Council/Chapter(s) Tournament Chairperson shall extend a written invitation to the State President and defending State Champions, to participate in the current tournament. The invitation shall list the exemption benefits. (If the State runs the tournament, the State Tournament Chairperson shall be responsible for extending the written invitation.)

## 10. CHAMPION BENEFITS:

A. Overall Low Gross Champion and Overall Low Net Champion are paid by MAGA State funds.

1. Charro Sombrero
2. Windbreaker with M.A.G.A. logo
3. Two (2) golf shirts with M.A.G. A. logo
4. Paid entry fee to State Tournament \& Two (2) nights paid lodging for the following years State Tournament
5. Additionally for the overall low gross State champion, a $\$ 500$ account will be available to cover entry fees and mileage when representing MAGA in non-association tournaments, or if he has not already received one, may elect to receive a MAGA state champion ring.
B. Low Gross Flight Champions are paid by State Tournament Funds.

Champions in the Men's (all men's flights inclusive), Ladies, Senior, Super Senior, Golden 80's and Junior Flights will each receive a Charro Sombrero.
11. STATE PRESIDENT BENEFITS: To be paid by MAGA State funds

1. Entry Fees to the State Tournament
2. Two nights lodging

## 12. JUNIORS:

A. The Junior Flight participants at the M.A.G.A. State Tournament must adhere to Rules of Play under State Tournament format. They shall pay standard green fees, dinner, and cart fee if mandatory.
B. Juniors entered into M.A.G.A. Tournament play cannot be awarded any type of gift certificate or monetary prizes. Trophies shall be awarded to the winners.
C. The hosting Council/Chapter may have a Junior competition in addition to the State Tournament competition. The competition may consist of a putting contest, long drive contest and/or a chipping contest. Awards cannot be gift cards or monetary, but may be golf clubs, golf balls or trophies.

## 13. RULES OF PLAY:

Rules of play at Annual State Tournament shall be consistent with the USGA Rules of Golf as modified by local Course Rules and the State Tournament Director or Committee.

4. Non-MAGA members, may play under Calloway scoring system.
B. PLACES PER FLIGHTS:

Tournament Committee can increase/decrease awards based on entries submitted by tournament deadline. Number of trophies will be determined by number of players in each flight. Any flight category can be split into multiple flights depending on the number of players (i.e., Senior Flt 1 and Senior Flt 2) Champions shall be eligible for only one trophy
